## **ESSEX vs YORKSHIRE**

Essex travelled to Castleford for the eighth fixture in the calendar needing as many points as possible to help maintain Premier status.

The worse possible start occurred as the **Ladies 'B'** lost 6-0, winning only 2-legs in the 6-sets played.

The **Men's 'B'** started poorly losing the first 2-sets before Rayleigh Rascal's Michael Pinnington (21.71) got Essex's first point in the 3<sup>rd</sup> set, winning 4-3. Brightlingsea's Allan Mathieson (26.31) and Alan Collins (29.39) added two further points in a disappointing 9-3 loss, and therefore Essex found themselves 15-3 down going into Sunday's 'A' team games.

The **Ladies 'A'** started with a lady of the match performance from Kelvedon's Stacey Ellis (22.43) winning 3-2, further victories from Clacton' Karen Breen (15.35) and Springfield's Donna Gleed (21.22) gave Essex a well-deserved 3-3 draw.

The **Men's 'A'** performed well and produced some superb darts to earn a 6-6 draw; Brentwood's Steve Johnson (27.70) was man of the match winning the 2<sup>nd</sup> set 4-1, Canvey's Phil Halls (27.29) won 4-3 to take the 3<sup>rd</sup> set, but then Yorkshire took control and the next 5-sets. However, Essex weren't finished as they won the final 4-sets with 4-3 wins for John Costigan (24.09) and Daniel Day (26.70), Phil Brewster (26.85) winning 4-2 and finally Wayne Gleed (23.99) winning 4-1.

The result was Yorkshire 27 Essex 12 which kept Essex in 7<sup>th</sup> in the overall table with relegation threatened Cheshire visiting Chelmsford in the final fixture of the season at the end of April.
